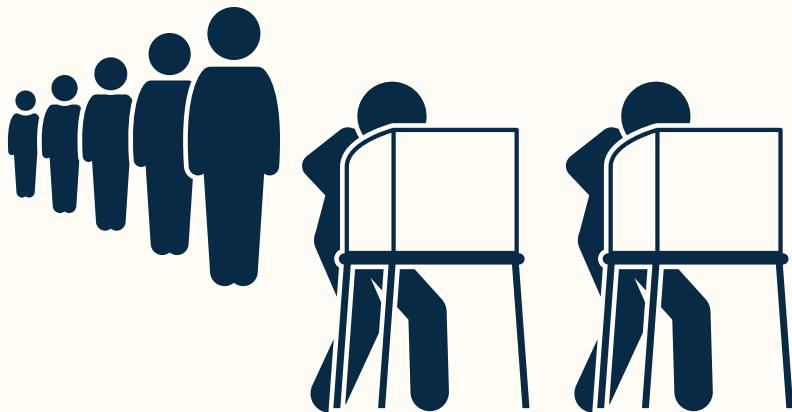

VOTING IN PERSON:

When voting in person on Election Day, your name and address on your voter registration must match your ID. The law does *NOT* require gender presentation to match your name or gender marker. If faced with issues, stay calm, disengage, and contact the Election Protection Hotline at 866-687-8683 for assistance.

If you do not have a valid ID when you go to vote, you can cast a provisional ballot upon request. Make sure to ask for follow-up instructions so that your ballot gets validated and counted afterward.



VOTE-BY-MAIL:
